

WINTER SATURDAYS AT THE FARM

Sprout Creek Farm is pleased to announce our popular Saturday at the Farm Program, open to boys and girls, ages 10-12. Each Saturday will be filled with farm activities such as feeding the animals (goats, cows, sheep, chickens, pigs, and ducks), milking cows, working in the barns with our farmers. Children will have the opportunity to learn about farm animals, and to help with routine farm chores such as moving hay or cleaning pens.

Come and be a farmer for a winter afternoon. Have fun working just as real farmers do! Join us for a typical day on the farm. We will spend our early afternoon working in the barns and then at 3:00, take part in animal chores - anything from milking cows to feeding goats, sheep, kids, chickens, ducks and gathering eggs! Children will be assisting with one of those chores, not all. Dress to stay warm and get dirty!

SCHEDULE: Saturday sessions begin at 1Pm and end at 5:30pm. Early drop-off and late pick-up are not available for the Saturday programs. Participants need to eat their lunch before they come. We will provide a mid afternoon snack. Tuition is \$50 per Saturday, with full payment required with the application. Program groups are small, so applications are processed in the order in which they are received.
