

## **Summer Camp Health Care Provider**



This is a Full Time seasonal position.

**Dates of Employment:** June 22, 2020 - August 21, 2020. Sunday (12pm - 3pm)  
Monday - Friday (8am - 4pm).

### **Job Description:**

The Summer Camp Health Care Provider will ensure the health and safety of Sprout Creek Farm campers (approximately 80 campers per week). This includes reviewing and screening campers' health forms and medications. May be required to receive calls after hours regarding particular overnight campers. This person serves as the primary decision maker in all medical emergencies that may occur at the camp. Responsible for recommending and providing appropriate care to all staff and campers. Must provide care and administer treatment in accordance with the NYDOH and HIPAA.

### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Supervises health and sanitation at summer camp
- Maintain health records for each camper and staff member.
- Provides basic first aid care, assesses injuries/illnesses, makes judgements on need for hospitalization or more advanced medical care
- Administers pre-prescribed and over the counter medications to all campers
- Maintain accurate records and log of medications and dispensaries.
- Reviews and maintains confidentiality of medical forms in compliance with HIPPA.
- Oversees initial health screening and daily health surveillance of all camp occupants
- Maintains daily medical log, to include how injuries occurred and how they were treated
- Takes responsibility for calling camper's parents and/or physician when warranted
- Relays necessary health information to summer education staff and provides education on signs and symptoms of potential problems, if necessary
- Establishes a system for health screening of arriving campers
- Supplies and maintains first aid kits for specified areas in camp and for out of camp trips and hikes.
- Conducts an inventory of supplies and places orders when necessary, ensuring the timely arrival of supplies.
- Screens incoming campers for any illnesses, infections, rashes, and other health concerns.
- Notifies the appropriate staff members of camper allergies, medications, and health concerns.
- Reports required incidents to local health department within 24 hours
- Accepts other responsibilities as deemed necessary by the Camp Director/Director of Education.
- Model healthy behaviors and periodically discuss health related topics with the campers (poison ivy and lyme disease prevention).
- Expected to stay on camp property while camp is in session and to periodically participate in camp activities.
- Accept other responsibilities as deemed necessary by the Camp Director/Director of Camp Administration.

### **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Certified EMT/WEMT &/or Licensed Practical Nurse
- Experience in healthcare setting
- CPR/First Aid certified
- Possess good leadership abilities and responsibility skills.
- Patient, enthusiastic, self-controlled and dependable.
- Ability to work with others and follow directions.
- Ability to physically assist campers with mobility impairment.
- Physical ability to respond appropriately to situations requiring first aid.
- Must be able to assist campers in an emergency (fire, evacuation, illness, or injury) and possess strength and endurance required to maintain constant supervision of campers.
- Camp operates on a working farm with uneven terrain. Must be able to walk across uneven and outdoor environment.

### **Preferred Qualifications**

- At least 4 years experience in a health care setting
- Registered Nurse, Nurse Practitioner, Physician's Assistant, NYS Licensed Physician
